


## **SLASHER KNIFE BANNER**

Thoughtfully designed by Nostalgic Yarn Creations





## **COLOR LEGEND:**

Color A	
Color B	
Color C	
Color D	

\*if there is a G indicated in the square, this is where I like to add in a white glow-in-the-dark yarn, but it is optional. You can use the same white as the others instead.

Feel free to change up the background color – maybe you have an overall feel for the blanket if you are stitching a bunch of blocks together?

## **BANNER WRITTEN PATTERN:**

The best part of these graph patterns is that you can use any weight of yarn you would like. I like to stick with using the hook the yarn manufacturer recommends on the packaging, and using the same weight and brand for the entire block if you can.

Begin from the bottom left corner – row 1, as shown on the chart. Turn and continue with row 2 from left to bottom. Turn and continue with row 3 bottom to left, etc.

\*NOTE – since this is a banner, we do not create squares in the white spaces – to create the banner shape either increase or decrease where shown. I like to add a marker to the "front" of the piece so you don't get all "turned around".

Starting points for each row:

L = LEFT

B = BOTTOM

T = TOP

R = RIGHT

For each of the squares in each row, the letter indicates the color – see the corresponding color legend above. The number indicates how many squares of that color you need to make. For



example, A6 = color A in the next 6 squares. The number in brackets at the end references the total number of squares for that row.

L ROW 24 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A8, C5, A7 (20)

L ROW 26 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A8, C5, A8 (21)

B ROW 27 - A9, C5, A7 (21)

L ROW 28 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A7, C2, D1, C1, A11 (22)

L/T ROW 30 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A6, B3, C2, A12 (23)



\*TIME TO DECREASE ON THE RIGHT (R) - YOU'RE HALFWAY THERE, KEEP GOING!

R ROW 31 - A12, C1, B4, A5 (22)

T ROW 32 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A5, B5, C1, A11 (22)

R ROW 33 - A11, B6, A4 (21)

T ROW 34 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A4, B6, A11 (21)

R ROW 35 - A11, B6, A3 (20)

T ROW 36 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A3, B5, A12 (20)

R ROW 37 - A12, B5, A2 (19)

T ROW 38 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A2, B5, C12 (19)

R ROW 39 - A12, B4, A2 (18)

T ROW 40 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A18 (18)

R ROW 41 - A17 (17)

T ROW 42 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A17 (17)

R ROW 43 - A16 (16)

T ROW 44 - INCREASE BY 1 USING A16 (16)

R ROW 45 - A15 (15)

\*STOP THERE, YOU'RE ALL DONE! (HIGH FIVE)

## **FULL BLOCK WRITTEN PATTERN:**

If you wanted to make this a full block instead you can use the following:

Begin from the bottom left corner – row 1, as shown on the chart. Turn and continue with row 2 from left to bottom. Turn and continue with row 3 bottom to left, etc.

Starting points for each row:

L = LEFT

B = BOTTOM

T = TOP

R = RIGHT

For each of the squares in each row, the letter indicates the color – see the corresponding color legend above. The number indicates how many squares of that color you need to make. For example, A6 = color A in the next 6 squares. The number in brackets at the end references the total number of squares for that row.
